



The Geneva Tumor Registry of the Department of Community Health and Medicine of the Faculty of Medicine aims to compile data for surveillance and research on cancer pathology throughout the Geneva region in close collaboration with all cantonal structures (public or private) involved in the treatment of cancer patients.

The Faculty of Medicine of the University of Geneva is seeking to fill a position of:

FULL or ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR in Cancer Epidemiology and Director of the Geneva tumor registry at the Department of Community Health and Medicine

CHARGE: This is a full-time position in the field of cancer epidemiology for a candidate with several years of experience at high-level academic research. He/she must have expertise in managing, analyzing, and interpreting large scale of databases. The expected incumbent will have to develop research at the national and international level and obtain external funding.

The candidate will be involved at undergraduate and postgraduate levels for teaching in cancer epidemiology as well as supervising Masters' and doctoral theses.

He/she will also be responsible for management and organization tasks at the Faculty of Medicine and at the Geneva tumor registry, including supervision of staff and the use of routine data.

REQUIREMENTS:

MD or MD-PhD or PhD or equivalent degree

Full postgraduate training in epidemiology is required

Good knowledge of the Swiss healthcare system

Experience in research management and teaching

Publications in international journals

The candidate should be fluent in French. Proficiency in

English required; knowledge of German would be an asset.
