To mark this occasion, *Health Promotion and Prevention Working Group* of the Swiss Society of Public Health is hosting a year-long lecture series exploring the development, implementation, and future prospects of the Ottawa Charter in Switzerland.

This year's meeting focuses on hands-on, practice-oriented teaching methods that bring epidemiological concepts to life through case-based simulations, role-play, and the use of Al tools. Participants will experience these methods as learners and leave with fresh ideas and materials for their own teaching.
