launched on 21.3. - Joachim Pelikan, Swiss TPH; Jorgen Bauwens, SSPH+

- Closed to media and the public
- Direct communication channel between FOPH and scientists
- FOPH asks questions, places data
- Expert community provides inputs, analyses, questions, discussion groups, collaborations
- Alternative to tweet, SMS, emails, “open letters” and other floods

Status quo:

>300 enrollees; continued needs-based development of platform and governance; highly appreciated by FOPH

Complementary to the Swiss National COVID-19 Science Task Force:

- Closed group of >40 elected members (many from SSPH+ network)

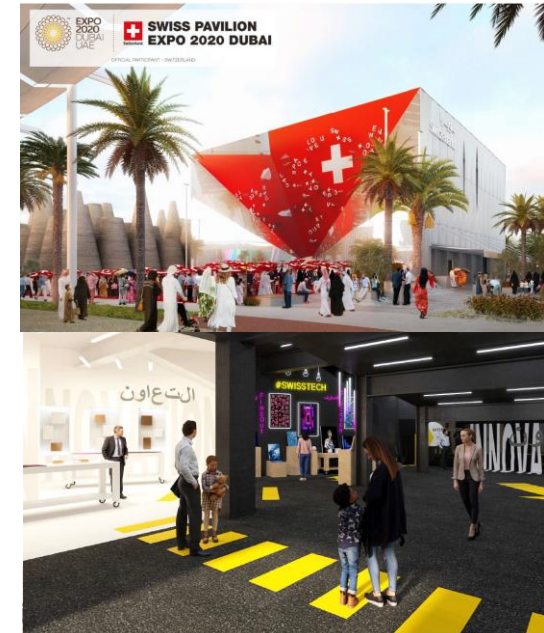
