Main activities within the Healthcare evaluation unit (UES):

- 1) Designing and carrying out survey and other projects on patients' and (healthcare) professionals' satisfaction, for the CHUV or other institutions, within the ESOPE team (patients' and employees' satisfaction surveys):
 - Designing and implementing survey projects
 - Collection of quantitative (questionnaires) and qualitative (focus groups, interviews) data, and management of corresponding databases
 - Carrying out statistical and/or qualitative analyses to produce results
 - Writing reports and presenting results to commissioning institutions
- 2) Participating in a research project on the evaluation of local determinants of the successful implementation of quality of care indicators in hospitals:
 - Participating in meetings and project organisation
 - carrying out interviews, focus groups and observations, and transcription of collected data
 - analysis of collected qualitative data
 - participating in the writing of newsletters, study reports and presentation media (in French and German)

Requirements

- very good editorial competence (French and German)
