**Weighted sum of 6 indicators:** (Web of Science documents  $\times 1$ ) + (Average times cited  $\times \frac{1}{3}$ ) + (% Highly cited papers  $\times \frac{1}{3}$ ) + (% Hot papers  $\times \frac{1}{3}$ ) + (% All open access documents  $\times 1$ ) + (% International collaborations  $\times 1$ )

# PhD training - Inter Graduate Campus (IGC)

## Structure

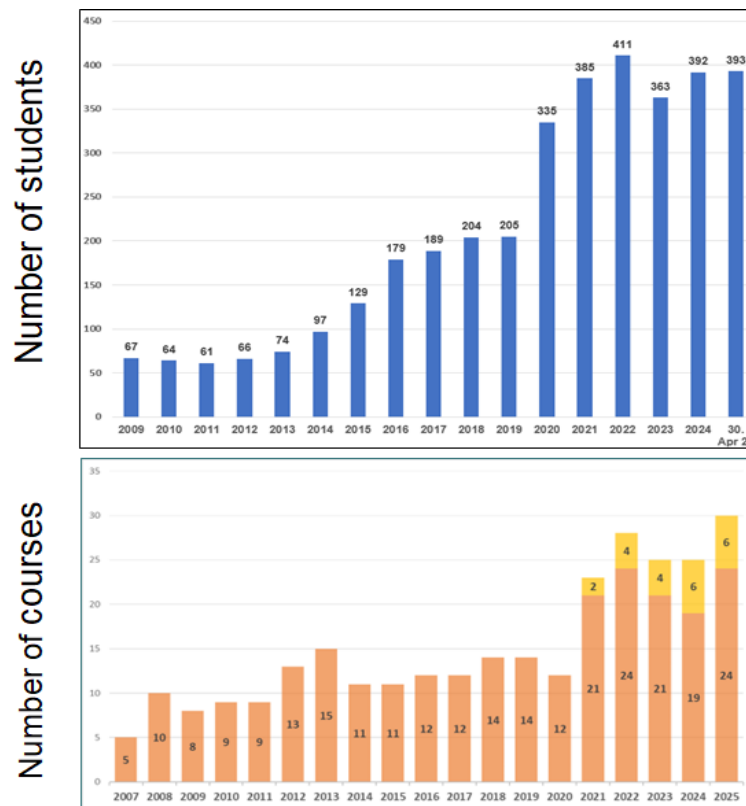

# PhD training - IGC (cont.)

## Collaboration with GLOHRA (German Alliance for Global Health Research)

### Idea:

- **Fieldtrip for 20 PhD students and postdocs to international organizations in Geneva** (WHO, Campus Biotech, UNICEF, DNDi, Alliance for Health Policy and Systems,...)
- Organized one year by GLOHRA, the other by SSPH+
- GLOHRA year: 16 GLOHRA students and postdocs, 4 IGC students and postdocs, 2 GLOHRA coordinators
- SSPH+ year: 16 IGC students and postdocs, 4 GLOHRA students and postdocs, 2 SSPH+ coordinators

### Budget:

- Ca. 20'000 CHF total costs per year for 5-day fieldtrip
- Travel costs, accommodation (shared bedrooms), food
- GLOHRA pays the total costs in 2026)
- SSPH+ pays the total costs in 2027

### Benefits for SSPH+ and IGC students and postdocs:

- International collaboration with a partner in the global health field
- Network opportunities for early career researchers with diverse disciplinary backgrounds\*
- Contacts to international organizations in Geneva already established by GLOHRA

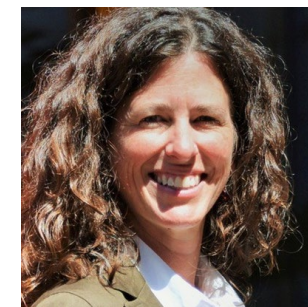

## Horizon scoping at FOPH Directorate meeting on 3 June 2025:

There is an urgent need for national coordination of measures to combat the shortage of health professionals!

A holistic view of the training of healthcare professionals is necessary in order to:

- eliminate possible disincentives

- draft a primary care planning across health professions

# MSCA-COFUND-2025 Proposal (new GlobalP3HS)

- SSPH+ is applying again for the MSCA COFUND to offer **36** new doctoral fellowships at one of the SSPH+ partner universities
- The application deadline is **24 June 2025**, and notification of funding from the EU is expected in November 2025
- **Key features** of the new GlobalP3HS are:
  - **Mobility Rule:** Students must come from **abroad (mobility rule)**, i.e. they must not have spent more than 12 months at a Swiss institution (for work or study purpose) in the 3 years before starting their PhD under GlobalP3HS
  - **Employment:** Students must be employed for a maximum of 48 months on the basis of the SNSF regulations
  - **Co-funding:** GlobalP3HS will run under a **CO-FUNDING scheme**. The EU provides a fixed amount of **EUR 3'300** per student month. The funds required by the host institution/supervisor for 48 months are estimated at around **CHF 106'500** per student, calculated with average social charges of 16% and including the costs for the GlobalP3HS manager (and depending on the Euro-CHF exchange rate).

# Swiss Cohort & Biobank and IOP4CH

## Sistierung 04/2025 aufgrund finanzieller Lage

### Ausgangslage:

- Die Schweiz hat zu **wenige qualitativ hochwertige Gesundheitsdaten**, um Interventionen effizient zu planen und gute Gesundheitsforschung zu betreiben.
- Die Schweiz bräuchte für den Krisenfall **eine verfügbare Infrastruktur**, um schnell Daten zu erheben (Zeitverzögerung bei Corona)
- Die **finanzielle Lage des Bundes** erlaubt es in den kommenden Jahren aber nicht, ein Projekt dieser Dimension zu realisieren.

### Infonotiz an den Bundesrat vom 30.04.2025 :

- Im Rahmen der Arbeiten der Projektgruppe FOR-SHeS hat sich gezeigt, dass zwar ein grosser Bedarf an einer solchen Gesundheitsstudie besteht, jedoch eine Finanzierung über interdepartementale Mittel für kein Amt möglich ist. Auch ist angesichts der finanziellen Lage des Bundes eine Finanzierung der in den genannten Grössenordnungen aktuell nicht möglich.
- Daher hat das EDI entschieden, dass das Projekt aktuell nicht weiterverfolgt werden soll. Die Ergebnisse sollen in einem Bericht aufgearbeitet und im vierten Quartal 2025 auf der Webseite des BAG veröffentlicht werden. Dadurch könnten die gemachten Erkenntnisse rund um die Umsetzung einer Gesundheitsstudie ggfs. zu einer zukünftigen Projektumsetzung genutzt werden.

**BREAKING NEWS**

- **IOP4CH** (the Imaging and Omics Platform for Swiss Citizen Health) was resubmitted to swissuniversities Research Infrastructures Call → with support from vice-rectors research and FOPH (in progress)
- Report by the FOPH and other federal offices to the Federal Council on the feasibility, management and financing of a cohort is suspended for financial reasons
- Public Health scientists are now in the lead to lobby for a national cohort → lobbying activities for parliamentarians with the help of an agency started with a kick-off workshop on 27 May 2025
- Contact to other relevant groups and initiatives (e.g., Swiss Personalized Health Network, Swiss Brain Health) to **avoid fragmentation**

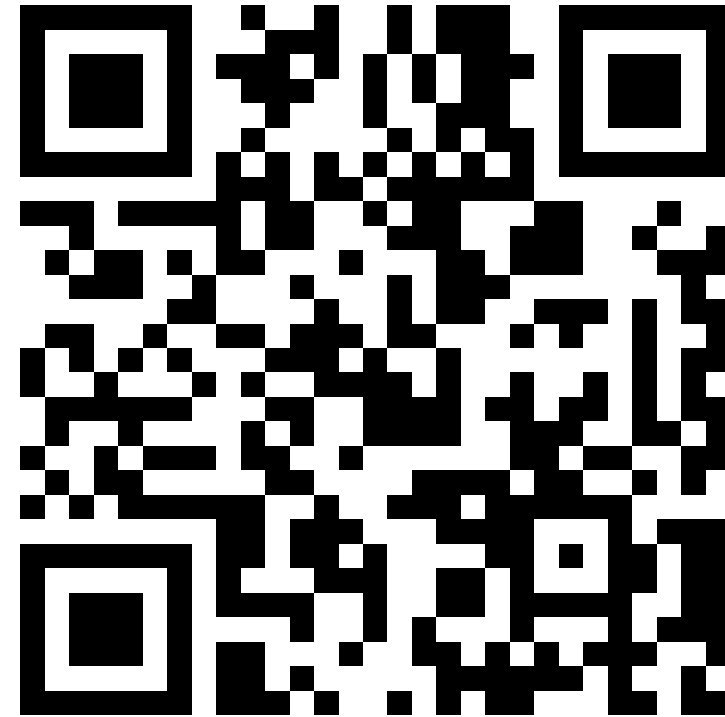
