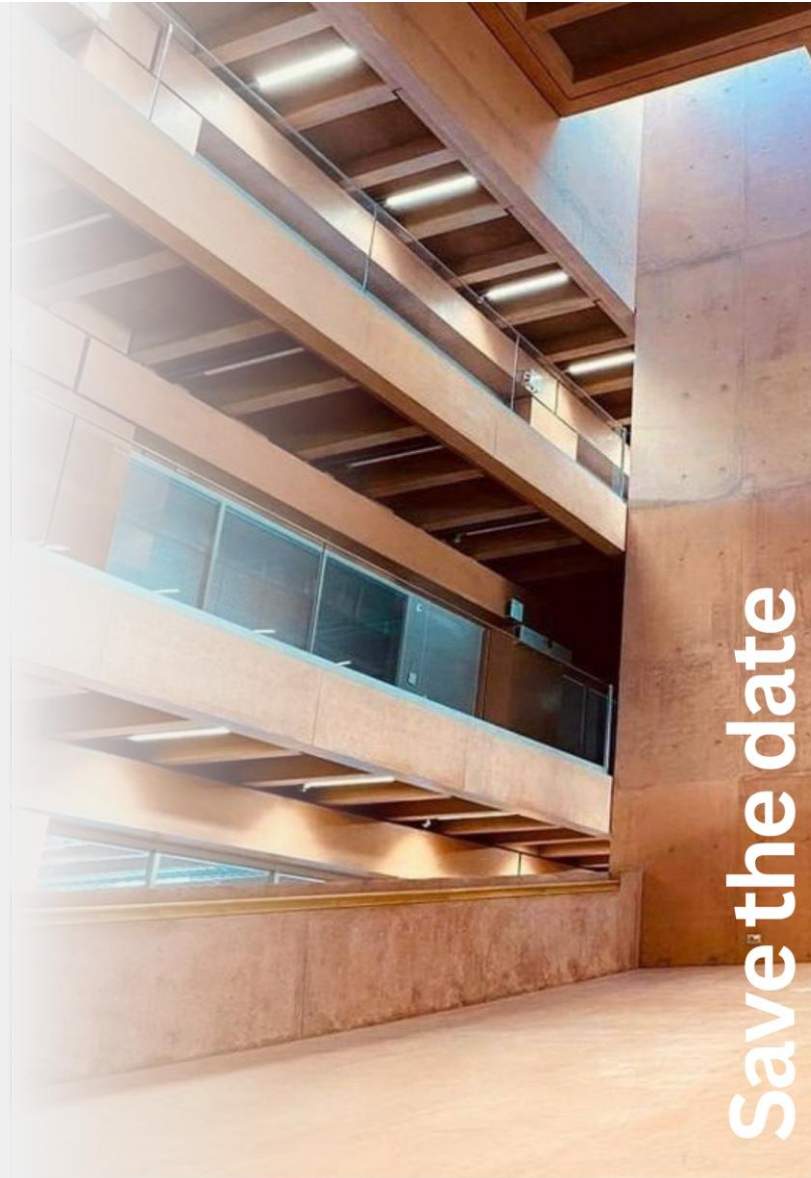

## CALL FOR THE BEST PUBLISHED PHD ARTICLE IN THE FIELD OF PUBLIC HEALTH

The Foundation Swiss School of Public Health (SSPH+) is promoting knowledge, skills and competencies in the field of public health. As a part of its effort to strengthen the PhD education in Switzerland, the SSPH+ is awarding the best published PhD article in the field of public health sciences.

### Beneficiaries:

- » PhD students who are registered in the [SSPH+ Inter-university Graduate Campus](#)

### Requirements:

- » The PhD student is **first author** of the article which is part of his/her PhD thesis
- » The article is of **relevance for public health**
- » The article (written in English) is published in (or accepted by) a **peer-reviewed journal**
- » The date of publication (or acceptance) is between **March 1, 2025 and February 28, 2026**
- » Only **one** article per PhD student will be accepted

### Award:

The winner of the best published PhD article will receive an award of **CHF 2'000.-**.

### Evaluation:

The submission will be evaluated by a panel consisting of experts from international academic public health institutions.
