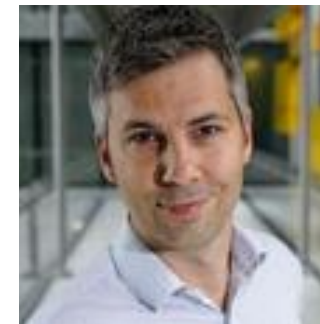

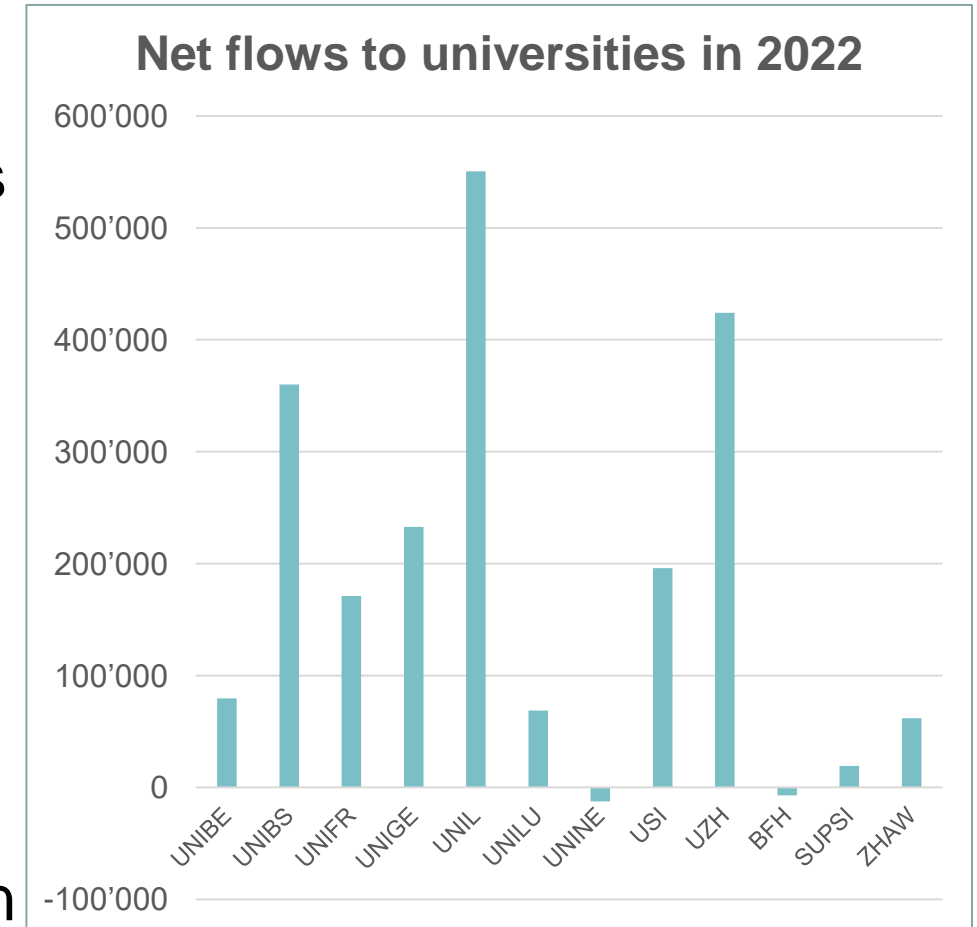

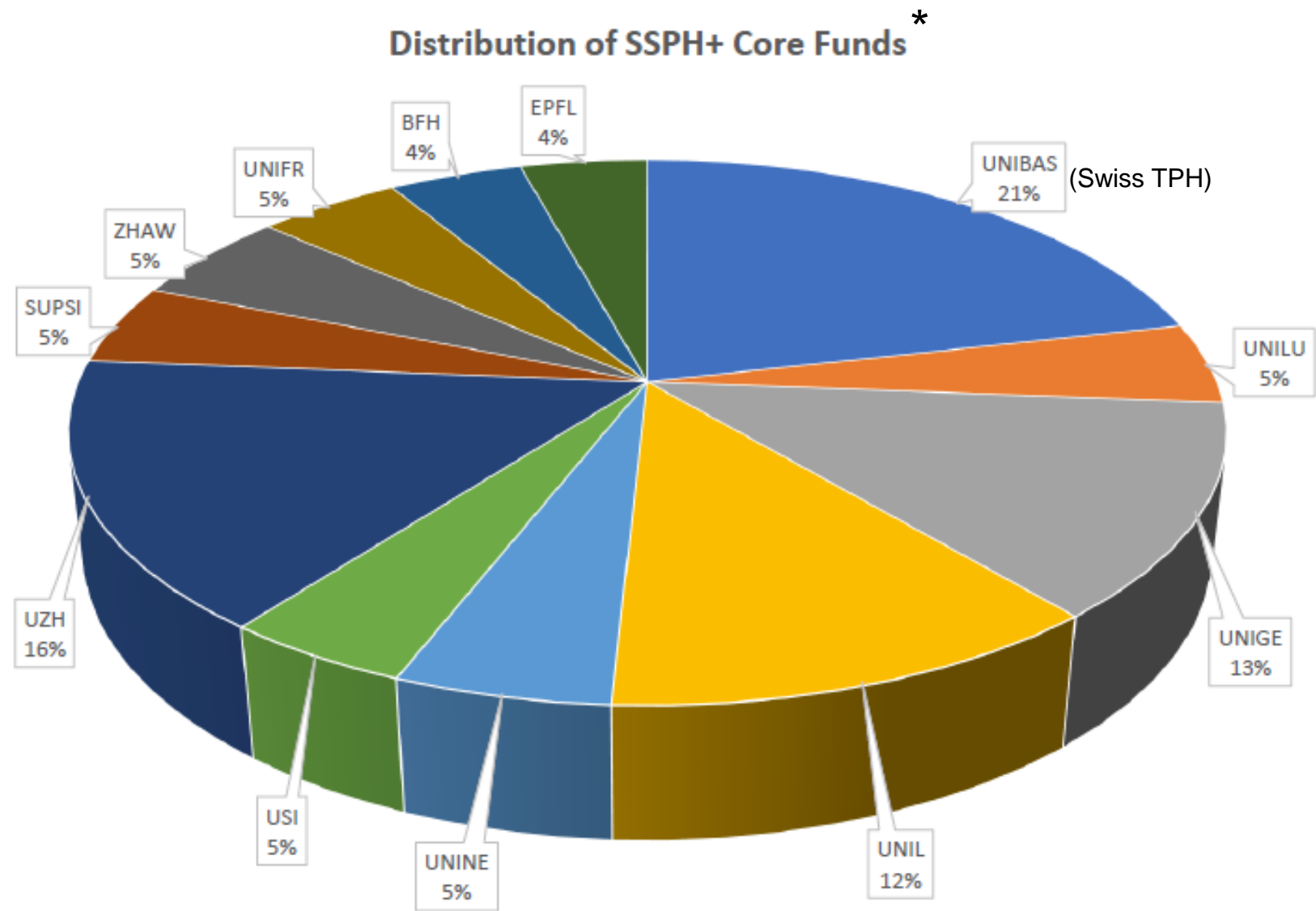
# Solid funding perspectives

SSPH+ funding from two sources:

- annual contributions from partner universities for core activities (~1 Mio CHF)
- contributions from funders/stakeholders for projects → amount varies each year and depends on the success of raising funds («fundraiser» not replaced)
- On average, a partner university receives three times as much money as it had to pay in

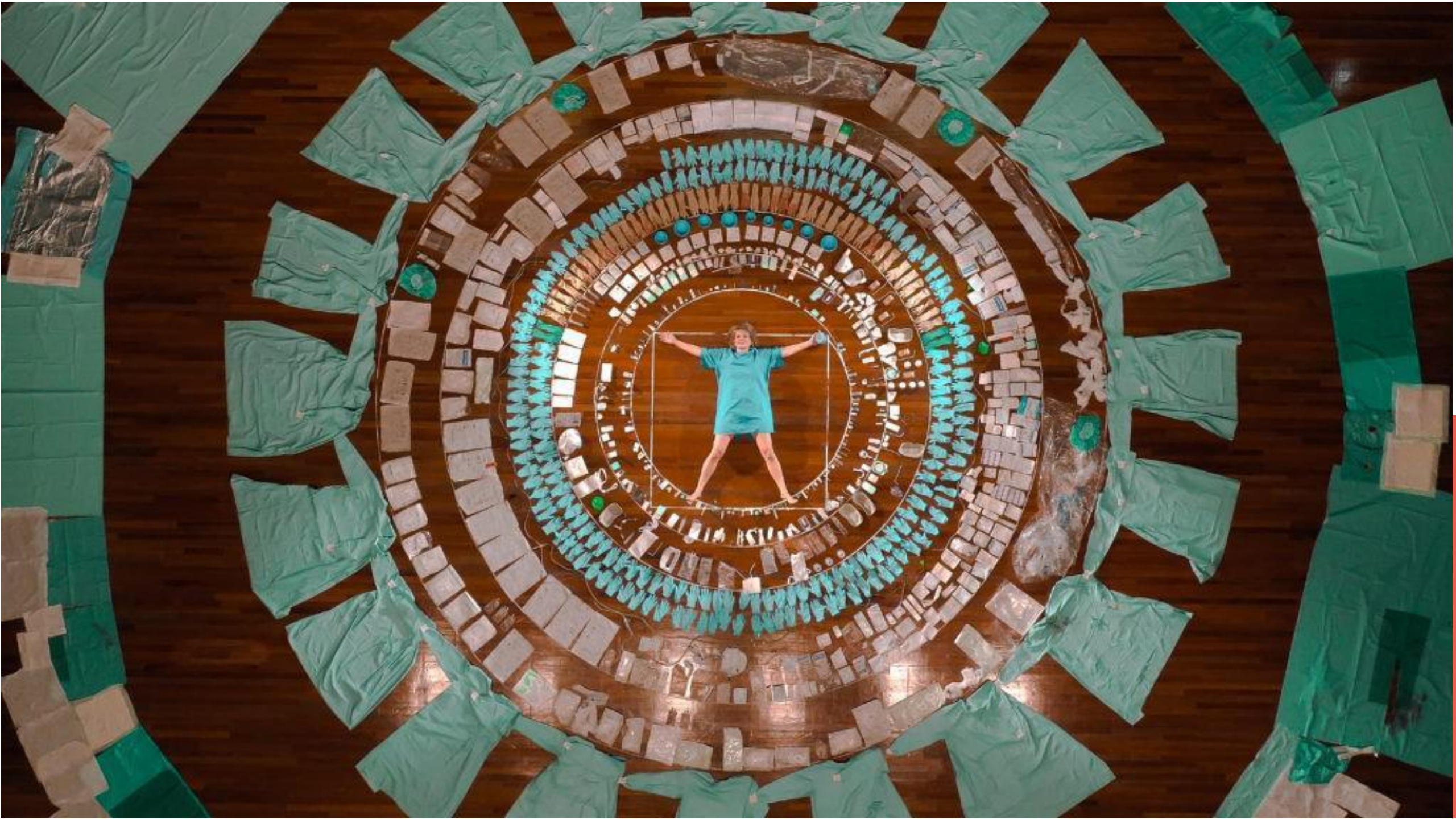

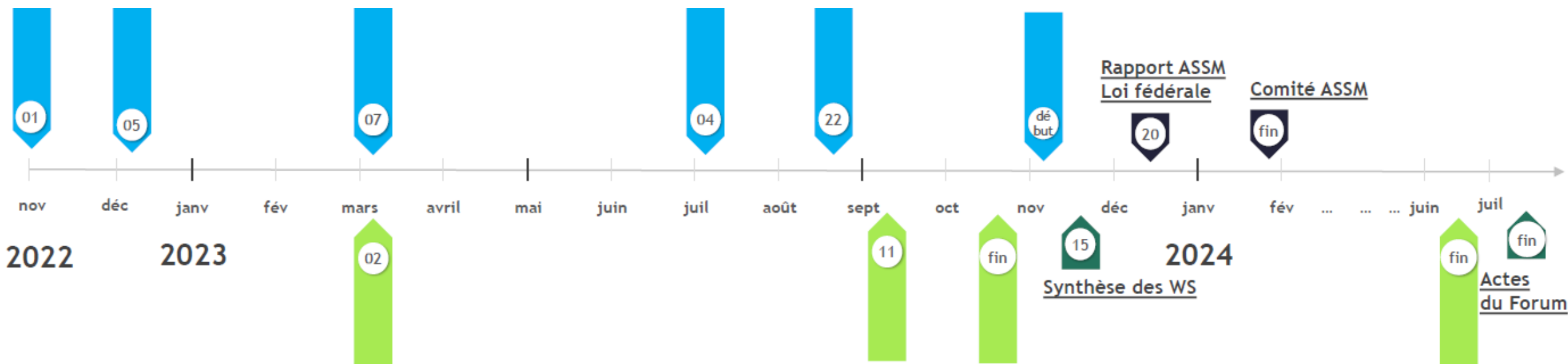

# The PHAR: sensitivity analysis

**Sensitivity analysis 1** (by Nino Künzli): five SSPH+ faculty members were chosen to compare their publication record (as listed on the institutional database) with the publications chosen by the algorithm.

- ✓ **Sensitivity of 87%** (= 13% of the publications actually made by those 5 SSPH+ affiliated members were missing)
- ✓ **Specificity of 67%** (= 33% of the articles included authors who were not formally affiliated with the SSPH+)
- ✓ **Impact:** analyses for the SSPH+ recalculated with a “worst case” correction factor of 33% (applied to the 3 indicators relating to publication volumes) → **the SSPH+’s rank moved from the 4<sup>th</sup> to the 6<sup>th</sup> rank.**

**Sensitivity analysis 2:** regarding the "international collaboration" indicator (14 schools of the PHAR use an estimate of this indicator, based on the university to which they are affiliated), a sensitivity analysis was conducted excluding this indicator to analyze the change of ranks without including it.

- ✓ **Impact:** changes of rank for some of the schools but → **4/5 of the top ranks are still occupied by the same schools.**

- Gold Open Access with rigorous peer review
- Q1 ranking among public health journals
- Published by Frontiers (Lausanne)



## 2022

- 931 submissions, 349 publications,
- 16 Calls initiated and led by leading researchers
- Young Researcher Editorial PhD training program published 8 Editorials
- [Globequity](#) program funded by [swissuniversities](#) waived APC for 23 authors from low- and middle-income countries
- 2023 submissions: full APC waiver for submissions co-authored by SSPH+ faculty (or their teams)

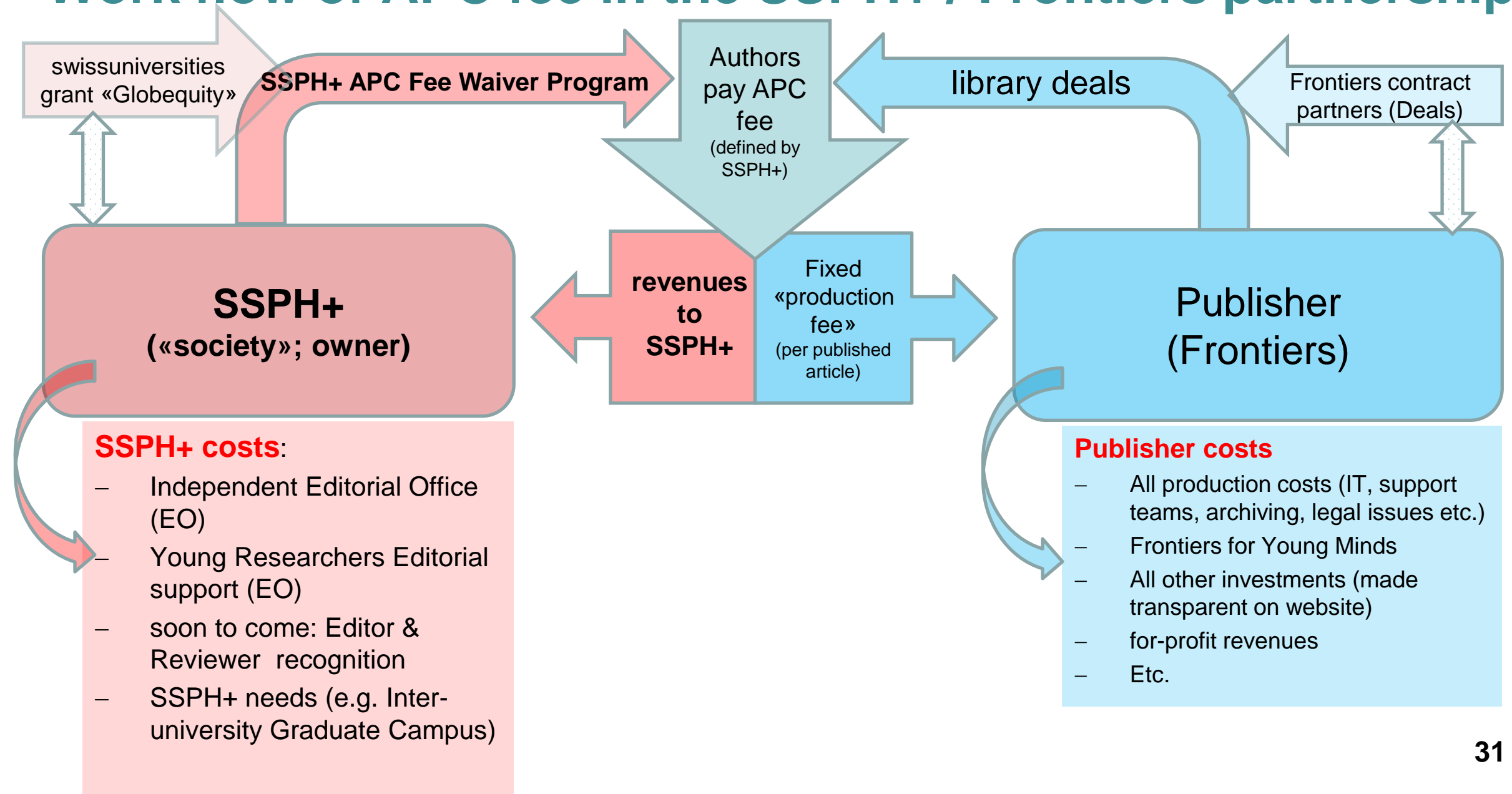




## «Society Journals» - a WIN-WIN for independent science

- Editorial Office, Editors, and editorial strategies (e.g. calls) are fully independent from publisher, share-holders or investors
- Thus, full scientific responsibility for content and quality
- Full financial transparency and control of revenues (APC fees)
- «Not-for-profit» guarantees 100% re-investments of revenues into «Society» (e.g. SSPH+)

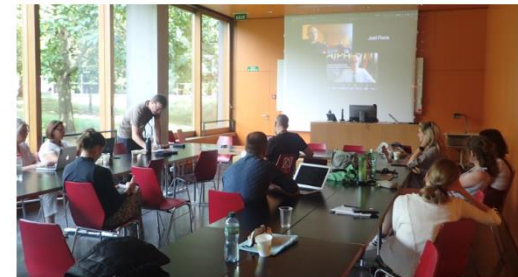




- **2022 (31<sup>st</sup>): Record-breaking number of participants joining online and onsite**
