Description This course will provide an orientation to health and medical research

> from a quantitative and epidemiological viewpoint. It will give an introduction to the design of public health and clinical research, and it will discuss measures of disease frequency and association, and the validity of research in medicine. The course will discuss recent developments in epidemiologic methods for public health and clinical research. It will review the various study designs and major issues in the validity of epidemiologic studies. It will give an overview of elements of

epidemiologic data-analysis.

Objectives The purpose of this introductory class is to discuss the principles and

methods of epidemiology for quantitative health research; to demonstrate their applicability in research in public health and clinical medicine; and to

demonstrate the interrelations of public health and clinical research.
