

A practical guide on how to submit, review, and get your paper published in Public Health Journals

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Description	Submitting, reviewing, and publishing papers is a key part of research, but it can be frustrating due to its complexity and time demands. This course offers a practical guide on how to navigate these steps effectively. It covers everything from formatting your paper to understanding publication fees and agreements. The goal is to equip you with the skills to format your papers efficiently, making revisions and resubmissions easier, and focused but not unique in Public Health.
Objectives	This course aims to provide students with the necessary skills to format their research papers for publication. We will cover better practices for dealing with: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Co-authors collaborations- First submission- Resubmission- Reviewer's answers- Final publication checks
