Objectives

Students will learn strategies and master tools that will help them structure their paper-writing process from beginning to end.

Students in this course *must* have completed data collection and most of their analysis and be ready to write (or have started writing) their paper draft. The course is also appropriate for those whose papers have been rejected and must be resubmitted to another journal.
